Learn to represent the human form using a variety of materials. During this course students will focus on creative expression as they develop new ways of using and combining materials while observing male and female models. Students must supply their own materials and are encouraged to bring a variety of different materials to class such as pen, pencils, ink, crayon, paint, pastels, collage materials, etc. This class is open to both beginner and advanced students.

Materials List: Mixed Media and the Figure

Students should gather a variety of different materials to bring to class. Please note that it is not necessary to purchase all new materials, students are encouraged to bring whatever materials they already own and add to their supplies as the class progresses.

Some suggested materials include; pencils, pens, markers, crayons, water soluble graphite, charcoal, conte crayons, watercolor and acrylic paint, oil pastels, chalk pastels, ink, food coloring, glue, gesso, collage materials (papers such as newspaper, magazines, scraps, etc.).

Suggested surfaces include paper, canvas, cardboard and wood. Students are encouraged to work with various sizes from 12" x 12" – 18" x 24".
