



#### <u>Step 1</u>


Cut or tear a light blue sheet into small pieces. Helpful hint:

keep pieces about stamp-size.




### <u>Step 2</u>

Glue the light blue pieces onto the dark blue paper. Set aside.



### <u>Step 3</u>

Choose any color sheet you want and fold it in half hamburger-style. Helpful hint: pick a bright color that looks good with blue!

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
#### Step 4

Cut or tear out a C-shaped hole from the folded side of the sheet. **Note:** do not cut the

paper in half!

#### <u>Step 5</u>

Unfold the paper to see your water droplet shape! Glue this paper on top of the blue collage to turn your water droplet blue.



#### <u>Step 6</u>

Search for blue objects (blue sky, blue butterfly or birds) in magazines and cut or tear them out. Glue them to your water droplet for more fun!









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
