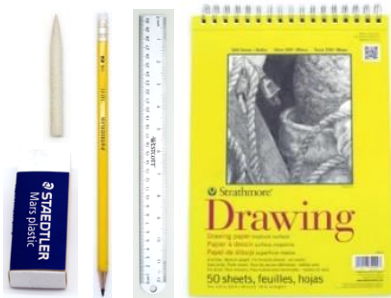

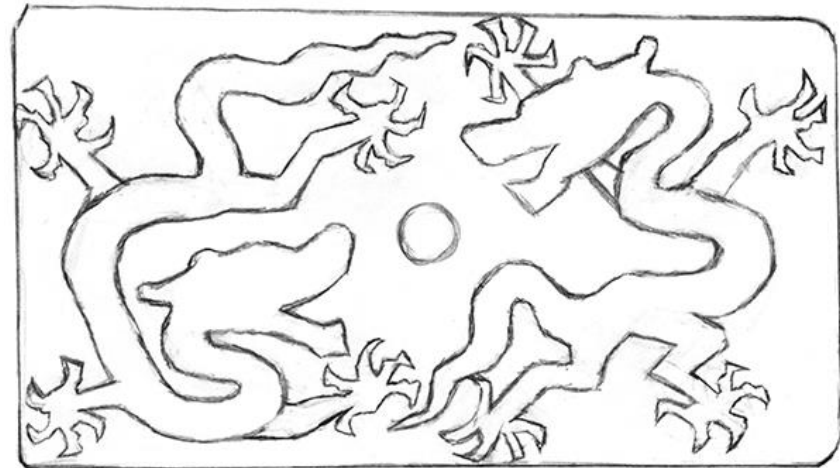
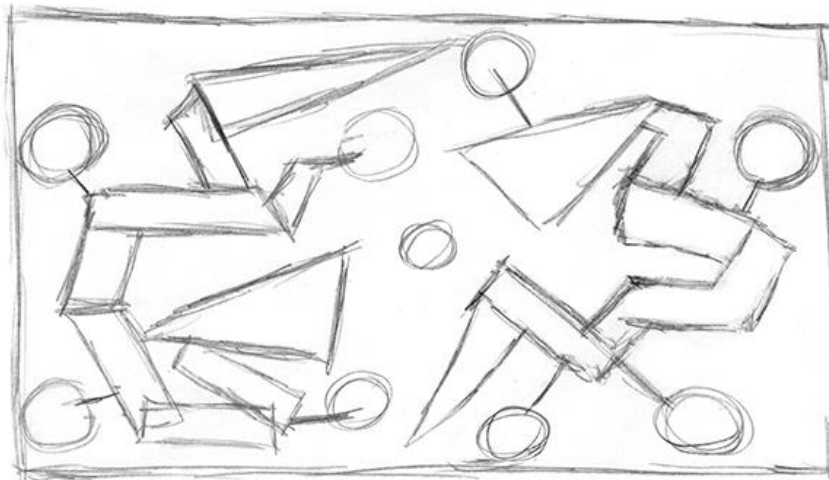
- pencil

Step 1

Draw the dragons using basic shapes, then refine the dragon's exterior contour. Erase lines as needed.

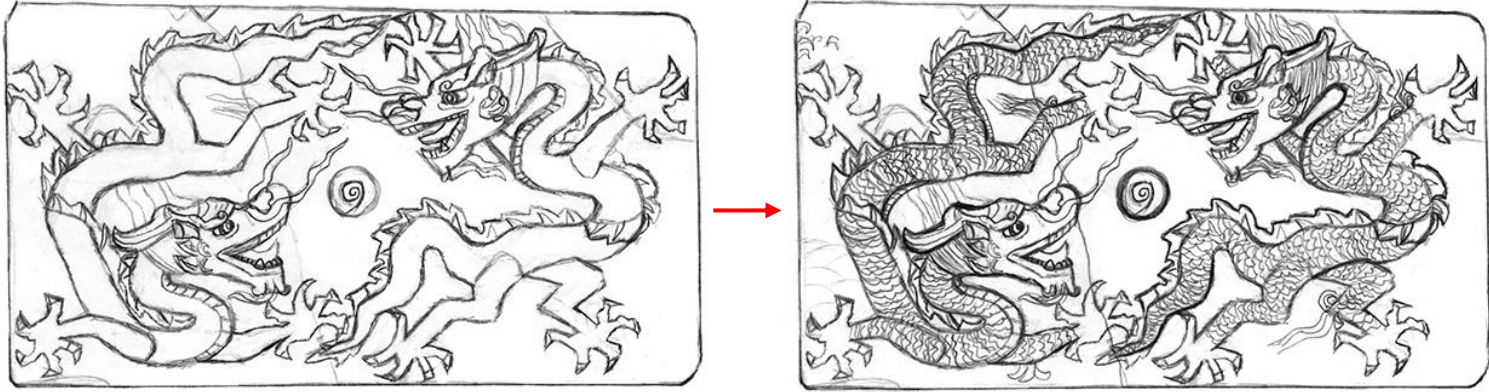

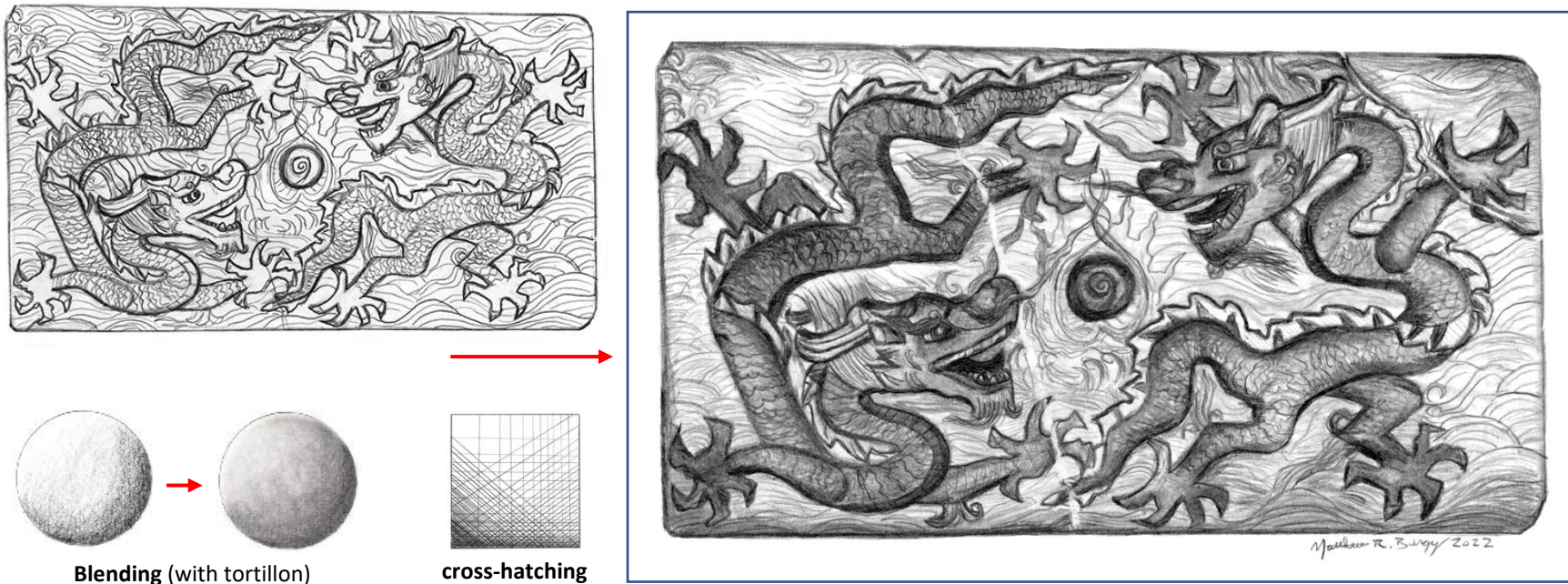
Step 2

Step 3

Add fine detail, texture, and value. Create value by using blending and cross-hatching techniques.
