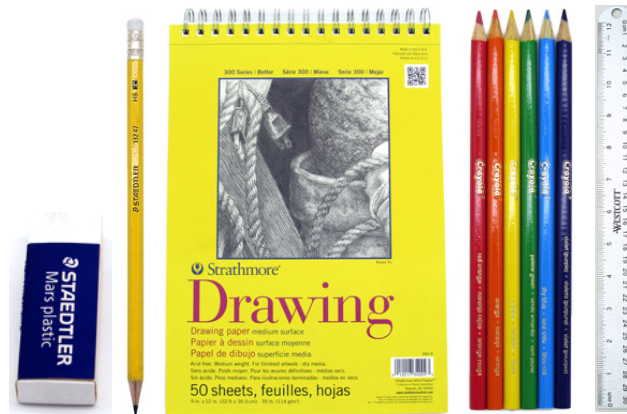

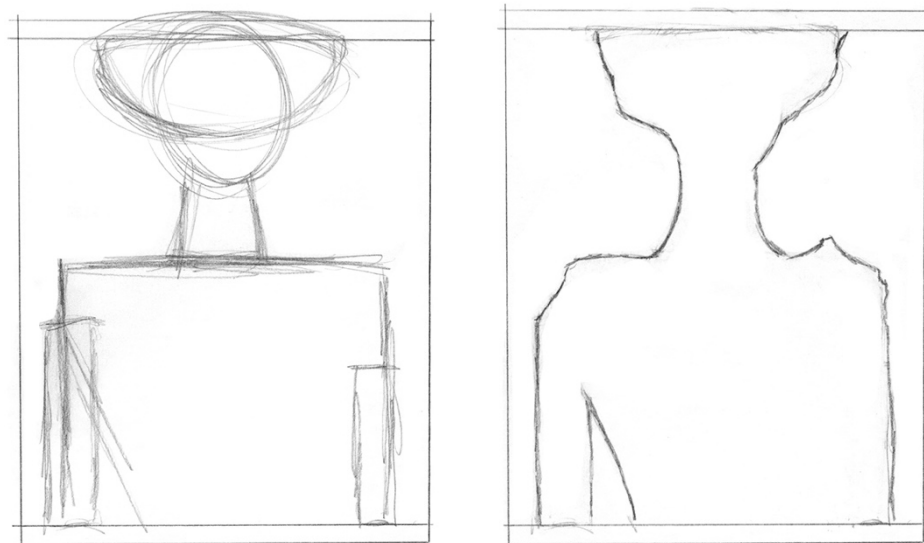


Supplies:

- pencil

- color pencils
- ruler (optional)

Step 1

Draw the doll in the photograph using basic shapes, then refine the doll's exterior contour. Erase lines as needed.

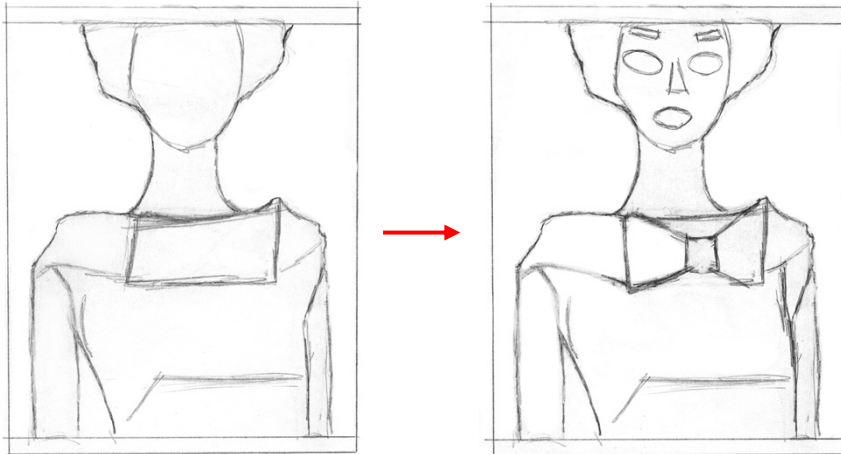

Step 2

Draw the basic interior shapes of the doll, then refine those shapes. Add more interior shapes as needed.



Step 3

Add fine details, texture, color, and value. Create rich color values by blending layers of color with firm pencil pressure. Erase to create highlights. Add the darkest colors and values last.
